
CONFIRMATION SPONSOR FORM

Sponsor Requirements: Code of Cannon Law 874 To be permitted to take on the function of a sponsor, a person must have completed the sixteenth year of age, be a Catholic who has been confirmed, and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist, and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function taken on, and not a mother or father of the candidate. Can. 892 The sponsor is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ, and faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this sacrament.

Sacrament of Confirmation Your Name

At the time of your Baptism, your parents were asked what name they had chosen for you. It was in this name that you were baptized into the Catholic faith, the Christian family. Since Baptism and Confirmation are both Sacraments of Initiation, in fact were originally one sacrament, it is preferable that at Confirmation you are identified by your baptismal name.

However, there may be a particular saint/holy person whom you see as a model of the Christian life. For this reason, you **may** chose his or her name for your confirmation name.
